Subject: 2001-03 Biennial Budget Statutory Language Proposal

The following is a statutory language proposal for the 2001-03 biennial budget. If you have any questions, please contact me at 266-7973 or kirsten.grinde@doa.state.wi.us.

The intent of this request is to eliminate the transfer of GPR to the environmental fund and convert and consolidate the associated nonpoint SEG appropriations to GPR. Currently, an amount of GPR is transferred to the environmental fund based on a certification by the Department of Transportation (DOT) of the supplemental title transfer fee revenue collected each year. The transferred moneys are then appropriated as segregated revenues (SEG) for nonpoint source pollution abatement associated activities.

The proposal would remove the required certification by DOT and the transfer of GPR [s. 20.855(4)(f)]. The proposal would also convert and consolidate several appropriations within the Departments of Natural Resources; Workforce Development (WCC); and Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection. A list of the appropriations and the action required for each is attached.

* Also, the proposal would lapse \$3.8 million from the environmental fund to the general fund.

Under current law, a registrant is required to pay a supplemental title fee of \$7.50 upon registering a new motor vehicle with DOT or, generally, upon applying for a new certificate of title following a transfer of a vehicle. Current law requires the secretary of transportation to certify annually the amount of supplemental fees collected during the previous fiscal year. An amount equal to the amount certified is then transferred from the general fund to the environmental fund.

This bill eliminates the transfer from the general fund to the environmental fund of an amount equal to the amount of supplemental title fees collected by DOT and eliminates the requirement that the secretary of transportation certify the amount of those fees. The bill changes several environmental fund appropriations into general fund appropriations and repeals other environmental fund appropriations. The bill repeals a general fund appropriation for the Wisconsin conservation corps and converts a general fund appropriation for DATCP's soil and water resource management program from continuing to biennial. The bill also transfers \$3,800,000 from the environmental fund to the general fund.

Under current law, a registrant is required to pay a supplemental title fee of \$7.50 upon registering a new motor vehicle with DOT or, generally, upon applying for a new certificate of title following a transfer of a vehicle. Current law requires the secretary of transportation to certify annually the amount of supplemental fees collected during the previous fiscal year. An amount equal to the amount certified is then transferred from the general fund to the environmental fund.

This bill eliminates the transfer from the general fund to the environmental fund of an amount equal to the amount of supplemental title fees collected by DOT and eliminates the requirement that the secretary of transportation certify the amount of those fees.
