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

Please have this statutory language change drafted for inclusion in the 2001-03 budget bill:

1. **Local Grant Program for Election Observer and Centralized Registration List**

The program would authorize the Elections Board to establish a training program for election observers and establish a grant program for local governments to enter registration data into a centralized registration list.

I have no other details on how the grant program would function, how much the grants would be for, etc. That issue has not been decided yet. Funding could be for just the training program or the grant program and this has not been decided yet either. I just wanted to alert you to this request and will provide more details later as details are decided.

## **Training for Election Observers and Centralized Registration List**

### **Options:**

#### **Centralized Registration List Grant Funding**

1. Provide \$70,000 GPR funding in FY03 for a grant program for local governments to help pay for costs of centralized registration list
  - Governor approved mandating registration in all municipalities and requiring a centralized computer registration list
  - Centralized list database would be maintained by Elections Board
  - Municipal and county clerks would add and delete registered voters from list
  - Grants would be determined by administrative rule by Elections Board

#### **Training of Election Observers**

2. Provide \$30,000 GPR funding in FY03 for required training program administered by Elections Board

SECTION 1. 5.05 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

5.05 (8) TRAINING OF OBSERVERS AT POLLING PLACES. The board shall conduct training programs to enable individuals exercising the right of access to polling places under s. 7.41 (1) to inform themselves concerning the elections laws, the procedures for conducting elections, and the rights of individuals who observe election proceedings. The board may charge participants in any programs for the cost of conducting the programs.

SECTION 2. 5.05 (10) of the statutes is created to read:

5.05 (10) GRANTS TO COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES. From the appropriation under s. 20.510 (1) (d), the board shall provide grants to counties and municipalities who apply for assistance to finance the cost of maintenance of the elector registration list under s. 6.33 (5). The board shall, by rule, prescribe an application procedure and an equitable method for allocation of grant moneys among counties and municipalities who apply for grants under this subsection.

SECTION 3. 20.510 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

20.510 (1) (d) Grants to counties and municipalities. The amounts in the schedule to provide grants to counties and municipalities under s. 5.05 (10) for maintenance of the elector registration list under s. 6.33 (5).

\*\*\*NOTE: This SECTION involves a change in an appropriation that must be reflected in the revised schedule in s. 20.005, stats.

SECTION 4. 20.510 (1) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.510 (1) (h) Materials and services. The amounts in the schedule for the cost of publishing documents, locating and copying records and conducting administrative meetings and conferences, and training sessions, and for supplies,

postage and shipping. All moneys received by the board from collections for sales of publications, copies of records and supplies, for postage, for shipping and records location fees and for charges assessed to participants in administrative meetings ~~and~~, conferences, and training sessions shall be credited to this appropriation account.

This bill directs the elections board to conduct training programs to enable individuals exercising the right of access to polling places to inform themselves concerning the election laws, the procedures for conducting elections, and the rights of individuals who observe election proceedings. The bill permits the board to charge participants for the cost of conducting the programs.

The bill also directs the board to provide grants from state general purpose revenue to counties and municipalities ~~who~~ apply for assistance to finance the cost of maintenance of the statewide elector registration list created by the bill. The bill directs the board to prescribe, by rule, an application procedure and an equitable method for allocation of grant moneys.

1. You should place an additional \$30,000 in your schedule under s. 20.510 (1) (a), stats. <sup>V</sup> for the 2001-2003 fiscal biennium to subsidize training programs for election observers. In case that is not enough, this draft also permits the elections board to charge participants in the programs for the cost of conducting the programs. Please let us know if this is not in accord with your intent.
2. You should also place \$70,000 in your schedule under proposed s. 20.510 (1) (d) for fiscal year 2002-03 to fund the grant program for maintenance of registration lists.
