LOCAL GOVERNMENT

* This bill directs DOR to study options for restructuring shared revenue and tax incremental financing to encourage high-growth sectors of the economy and the creation of high-quality jobs in this state. DOR must report the results of its study to the secretary of administration no later than November 1, 2002.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 9144. Nonstatutory provisions; revenue.

3 (1) STUDY ON PROMPTING ECONOMIC GROWTH. The department of revenue shall
4 study options for restructuring shared revenue and tax incremental financing to
5 encourage high-growth sectors of the economy and the creation of high-quality jobs
6 in this state. The study shall include considering using up to 10% of the amount
7 distributed to counties and municipalities under section 79.03 of the statutes to

1 match local efforts to encourage creation of high⁷quality jobs in this state. No later
2 than November 1, 2002, the department of revenue[✓] shall report the result of its study
3 to the secretary of administration.
