
Drafting requests for 2001-03 Biennial Budget Bill

Governor Thompson,

I am writing on behalf of the Wisconsin Register of Deeds Association to ask that you include in the upcoming biennial budget a provision that would update Wisconsin Statute 59.43(2)(b). This statute sets the fees for copies and the fee for certification of copies of documents recorded in the Register of Deeds office. This provision has not been adjusted in twenty years.

Specifically, we are requesting that the fee for certification of copies be adjusted from \$0.25 to \$1.00. No adjustment to the copy fees is sought at this time.

We believe that a \$1.00 fee more accurately reflects the cost of providing the certification service and that those individuals who request this service should bear its cost. While this fee is not a large source of revenue for any county, we still maintain that the cost of services like this should not be underwritten by property tax dollars, but rather by those who utilize such services.



OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Under current law, a register of deeds is authorized to charge a fee to provide copies of documents that are recorded in his or her office, and he or she is also authorized to charge a fee to certify the copies. Currently, the copying fees are \$2 for the first page of a document and \$1 for each additional page, plus 25 cents to certify the copy of the document. None of these fees apply to the department of the research, however.

This bill increases the certification fee to \$1.

For further information see the **state and local** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.43 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

(1) REGISTER OF DEEDS FEES TO CERTIFY COPIES. The treatment of section 59.43 (2) (b) of the statutes first applies to copies that are certified on the effective date of this subsection.
