Current law establishes a dwelling code council that, among other things, reviews the standards and rules for the construction of ~~one~~ and ~~0~~-family dwellings. The dwelling code council currently consists of 17 members, each of whom represents a specified interest group or the public. This bill requires the dwelling code council to include an additional member who represents remodeling contractors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 15.157 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
3 15.157 (3) DWELLING CODE COUNCIL. There is created in the department of
4 commerce, a dwelling code council, consisting of 17 18 members appointed for
5 staggered 3-year terms. Four members shall be representatives of building trade

1 labor organizations; 4 members shall be certified building inspectors employed by
 2 local units of government; 2 members shall be representatives of building contractors
 3 actively engaged in on-site construction of one- and 2-family housing; 2 members
 4 shall be representatives of manufacturers or installers of manufactured one- and
 5 2-family housing; one member shall be an architect, engineer or designer actively
 6 engaged in the design or evaluation of one- and 2-family housing; 2 members shall
 7 represent the construction material supply industry; one member shall represent
 8 remodeling contractors actively engaged in the remodeling of one-^{family} and 2-family
 9 housing; and 2 members shall represent the public, one of whom shall represent
 10 persons with disabilities, as defined in s. 106.50 (1m) (g). An employee of the
 11 department designated by the secretary of commerce shall serve as nonvoting
 12 secretary of the council. The council shall meet at least twice a year. Eleven members
 13 of the council shall constitute a quorum. For the purpose of conducting business a
 14 majority vote of the council is required.

15 **SECTION 9110. Nonstatutory provisions; commerce.**

16 (1) DWELLING CODE COUNCIL. Notwithstanding the length of terms specified for
 17 members of the dwelling code council appointed under section 15.157 (3) of the
 18 statutes, as affected by this act, the member appointed under ~~that subsection~~ as a
 19 representative of remodeling contractors shall be initially appointed for a term
 20 expiring on July 1, 2004.
