

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

The bill transfers from the department of commerce to the office of the governor one employee who is performing duties primarily related to rural policy development.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 9110. Nonstatutory provisions; commerce.

3 (1) EMPLOYEE TRANSFER. ✓ On the effective date of this subsection, ✓ 1.0 FTE GPR

4 position in the department of commerce, funded from the appropriation under

5 section 20.143 (1) (a) ✓ of the statutes and primarily related to rural policy

SECTION 9110

1 development, as determined by the secretary of administration, and the incumbent
2 employee holding that position, is transferred to the office of the governor, to be
3 funded from the appropriation under section 20.525 (1) (a) of the statutes, for the
4 purpose of rural policy development. The employee transferred under this
5 subsection has all the rights and the same status under subchapter V of chapter 111
6 and chapter 230 of the statutes in the office of the governor that the employee enjoyed
7 in the department of commerce immediately before the transfer. Notwithstanding
8 section 230.28 (4) of the statutes, no employee so transferred who has attained
9 permanent status in class is required to serve a probationary period.

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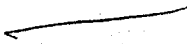
