Note: We are not specifying how much DOT needs to allocate to each program.

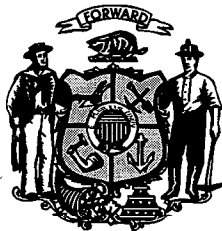

I am forwarding a statutory language change that we would like to have drafted for inclusion in the Department of Transportation's budget.

1. The intent of this request is to require the Department of Transportation to distribute \$529,000 SEG in FY02 and \$4,611,000 SEG in FY03 from s.20.395 (2)(fr) for the Town Road Improvement - Discretionary Program (TRIP-D) and the Municipal Street Improvement Program (MSIP). These amounts are to be in addition to the allocation of funds normally granted to the TRIP-D and MSIP programs.

HIGHWAYS

Under current law, DOT administers a local roads improvement program, which includes an entitlement component and a non-entitlement component. Under the non-entitlement component, DOT allocates \$500,000 in each fiscal year to fund eligible town road improvements and \$750,000 in each fiscal year to fund eligible municipal street improvements. This bill requires DOT to make additional allocations, for these purposes, of \$529,000 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$4,611,000 in fiscal year 2002-03. The bill does not require any specific apportionment of these funds between eligible town road improvements and eligible municipal street improvements.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 86.31 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 86.31 (2) (a) The department shall administer a local roads improvement
2 program to accelerate the improvement of seriously deteriorating local roads by
3 reimbursing political subdivisions for improvements. The selection of improvements
4 that may be funded under the program shall be performed by officials of each political
5 subdivision, consistent with the requirements of subs. (3), ~~(3g)~~, ~~(3m)~~ and ~~(3r)~~ to (3t).
6 The department shall notify each county highway commissioner of any deadline that
7 affects eligibility for reimbursement under the program no later than 15 days before
8 such deadline.

9 **SECTION 2.** 86.31 (3) (b) (intro) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 86.31 (3) (b) (intro) From the appropriation under s. 20.395 (2) (fr), after first
11 deducting the funds allocated under subs. ~~(3g)~~, ~~(3m)~~ and ~~(3r)~~ to (3t), the department
12 shall allocate funds for entitlement as follows:

13 **SECTION 3.** 86.31 (3t) of the statutes is created to read:

14 86.31 (3t) TOWN ROAD AND MUNICIPAL STREET IMPROVEMENTS. From the
15 appropriation under s. 20.395 (2) (fr), the department shall allocate \$529,000 in fiscal
16 year 2001–02 and \$4,611,000 in fiscal year 2002–03 to fund town road improvements
17 with eligible costs totaling \$100,000 or more and to fund municipal street
18 improvement projects having total estimated costs of \$250,000 or more. The funding
19 of improvements under this subsection is in addition to the allocation of funds for
20 entitlements under sub. (3) and the allocation of funds under subs. ~~(3m)~~ and ~~(3r)~~.

21 **SECTION 4.** 86.31 (6) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

22 86.31 (6) (d) Procedures for reimbursements for county trunk highway
23 improvements under sub. (3g), for town road improvements under ~~sub.~~ subs. ~~(3m)~~
24 and (3t), and for municipal street improvements under ~~sub.~~ subs. ~~(3r)~~ and (3t).
