I just wanted to mention that the new draft request (below) will affect LRB-2263/1, which provides UW with the authority to grant a fee remission to a Wi State Science Fair champion. LRB-2263/1 creates 36.27 (1)(am) 7. However, 36.27 (1)(am) would be deleted under the new request (below). We do still want to retain the fee remission, and have the UW absorb it from its student academic fee revenues.

Lonnie,

During our final comeback session with the Lt. Gov. last night, the decision was made to give the University complete continuing appropriation authority for its appropriation for student academic fees [20.285 (1)(im)], and to remove the restrictions for which the Board of Regents may raise undergraduate tuition.

Essentially, we'd like to remove the language that talks about the purposes for which the Board of Regents may raise resident undergraduate tuition - that is, delete 36.27(1)(am). I don't think there would be any changes required for the language under 20.285 (1)(im) - it appears to already be written as a continuing appropriation (but I could be wrong).

Dawn, this is a **new** request.

HIGHER EDUCATION

Current law prohibits the UW board of regents (board) from increasing resident, undergraduate tuition beyond an amount that is sufficient to fund certain costs, such as compensation and fringe benefits for UW employees and the costs of nontraditional courses, but permits the board to spend up to the entire amount of tuition received. Beginning in the 2002-03 academic year, this bill eliminates the restrictions on increasing resident undergraduate tuition.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 36.27 ^X(1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 36.27 (1) (a) Subject to pars. ~~(am)~~[✓], (b) and (c), the board may establish for

4 different classes of students differing tuition and fees incidental to enrollment in

1 educational programs or use of facilities in the system. Except as otherwise provided
2 in this section, the board may charge any student who is not exempted by this section
3 a nonresident tuition. The board may establish special rates of tuition and fees for
4 the extension and summer sessions and such other studies or courses of instruction
5 as the board deems advisable.

6 **SECTION 2.** 36.27 (1) (am) of the statutes is repealed.

7 **SECTION 9356. Initial applicability; University of Wisconsin System.**

8 (1) ACADEMIC FEES. The treatment of sections 36.27 (1) (a) and (am) of the
9 statutes first applies to the setting of resident, undergraduate academic fees for the
10 2002-03 academic year.
