

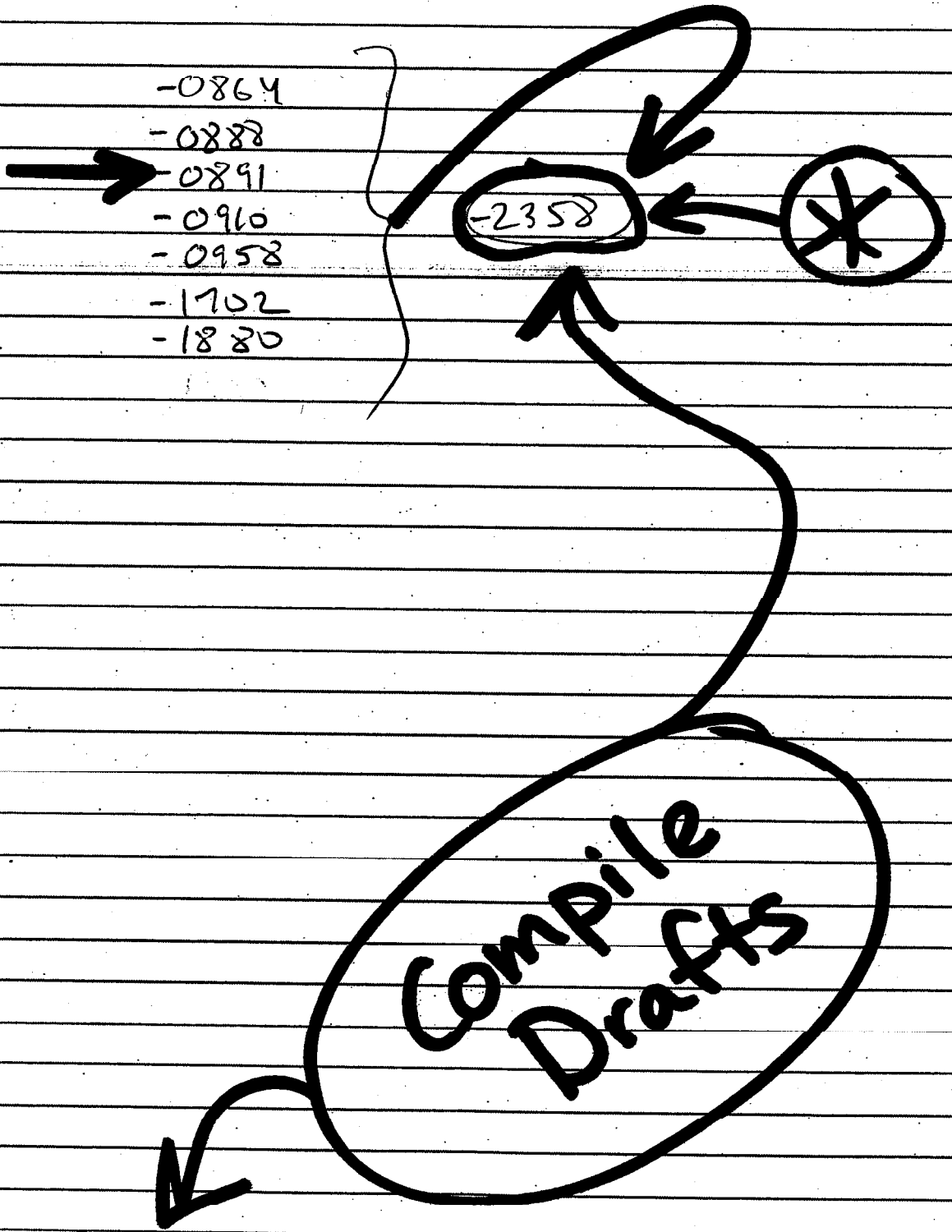



Brief Description of Intent: Add language stating that the State Superintendent must allow a person to view any s. 118.30, Wis. Stats., examination if the person submits a written request to do so to the State Superintendent within 90 days after the date of the administration of the exam. (This provision does not apply while an examination is being developed or validated.) The State Superintendent must promulgate administrative rules to establish procedures to administer this provision. To the extent feasible these rules must protect the security and the confidentiality of the exams administered under s. 118.30, Wis. Stats. This provision gives DPI the authority to protect test security. This language was included in sections 3 and 4 of Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 to 1999 Assembly Bill 663, and sections 3 and 4 of Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 1999 Senate Bill 333.
