1 AN ACT to amend 20.445 (3) (md) and 121.15 (3m) (a) 2.; and to create 20.255  
2 (2) (kn) and 49.175 (1) (zo) of the statutes; relating to: grants for after-school  
3 care programs and making appropriations.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes the state superintendent of public instruction to award grants to school districts in the 2000-01 and 2001-02 school years is for after-school care programs. To be eligible to receive a grant, a school district must enroll pupils who are eligible to receive money under the federal temporary assistance to needy families (TANF) program and who would otherwise be unsupervised by an adult in the afternoon after school. The state superintendent must evenly distribute the grants among rural, suburban and urban school districts.

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

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**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill specifies that \$150,000 in Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) shall be allocated to the Department of Public Instruction for the purpose of providing grants for after-school programs.

**Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

TANF must be reauthorized by Congress prior to September 30, 2002. It is likely Congress will reduce and/or reallocate TANF funding to Wisconsin during this process. Given the uncertainty of TANF funding due to reauthorization, coupled with the TANF structural deficit, the long term availability of funds is questionable.

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill authorizes the state superintendent of public instruction to award grants to school districts in the 2000-01 and 2001-02 school years for after-school programs. **Local Fiscal Effect:**

School districts that receive grants for after school programs would share \$150,000 annually in federal TANF funds.
