Amalysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes the state superintendent of public instruction to award grants to school districts in the 2000-01 and 2001-02 school years is for after-school care programs. To be eligible to receive a grant, a school district must enroll pupils who are eligible to receive money under the federal temporary assistance to needy families (ZANF) program and who would otherwise be unsupervised by an adult in the afternoon after school. The state superintendent must evenly distribute the grants among rural, suburban and urban school districts.

(a) A school board may apply to the state superintendent of public instruction
