***Drafting Instructions to Amend the TEACH Educational Technology and Training and Technical Assistance Grants Program***

***(s. 44.72 (1), Stats.)***

- Direct the TEACH Board, notwithstanding the application requirements in s. 44.72 (1) (intro.) and the TEACH Board's duties in s. 44.72 (1) (a) to (c), to award annual Educational Technology and Training and Technical Assistance Grants for FY 2001-02 and FY 2002-03 to the recipients of these grants in FY 2001-02.
- Direct the TEACH Board to set the amount of the annual grants to be the amount equal to the grant that the recipient received in FY 2001-02. If the funds available for the grants in FY 2001-02 or FY 2002-03 exceed or are less than the total amount of the grants under this program in FY 2000-01, direct the Board to prorate the available grant funds awarded a recipient in proportion to the portion of the total amount of grants awarded to the recipient in FY 2001-02.
- Authorize a grant recipient to expend grant funds on any technical assistance and training in the use of educational technology that the grant recipient deems appropriate, provided that the grant recipient agrees, as a condition of receiving a grant, to report to the TEACH Board how the recipient spent its grant funds.

Under *Milwaukee Brewers Baseball Club v. Wisconsin Dept. of Health and Social Services*, 130 Wis. 2d 79, 115 (1986), "a legislative provision which is specific to any person, place or thing is a private or local law within the meaning of art. IV, sec. 18, unless: 1) the general subject matter of the provision relates to a state responsibility of statewide dimension; and 2) its enactment will have direct and immediate effect on a specific statewide concern or interest." This proposal is applicable only to the Village of Ashwaubenon.
