Dear Senator Hanson:

I am writing to thank you for being willing to listen to the Wisconsin Educational Media Association's (WEMA's) concerns and for taking the time to reply to my letter. I realize how difficult this budget process is, especially in light of decreased revenue estimates. However, the educational related items are worthy of your support and are very important to the 1200 members of WEMA and to the people, your constituents, whom we serve.

Previously, I had expressed WEMA's concern about the potential loss of the Department of Public Instruction School Library Media Consultant position in the Division for Libraries, Technology, and Community Learning (DLTCL). It was recently made vacant by Richard Sorensen's retirement. I noted that, in his capacity as the DLTCL School Library Media Consultant, Dick Sorensen provided many valuable services for school districts and school library media centers.

Another valuable service, Mr. Sorensen provided was coordination of the Governor's Wisconsin Educational Technology Conference. After his retirement, another person in the DLTCL has temporarily assumed responsibility for managing this annual conference. The next conference is scheduled for the KI Conference Center in Green Bay in the fall of 2001. Although the Department of Public of Public Instruction has staff experienced in managing this conference, the Governor's budget recommendations include a provision for a new 1.0 FTE TEACH Wisconsin staff position and related funding to manage the Governor's Wisconsin Educational Technology Conference (GWETC). Instead of creating a new position, why not use these funds to maintain an existing position that incorporates the GWETC responsibilities in addition to providing the leadership and guidance school administrators and school library media specialists need going into the 21st Century?

I am writing to ask you to work with the members of the Joint Finance Committee members and during caucuses to make the School Library Media Consultant position permanent through a line item in the budget. Funding for this permanent position could come from the proposed permanent GWETC manager position in the proposed TEACH budget.

Please give this request serious consideration. I look forward to working with you this session.

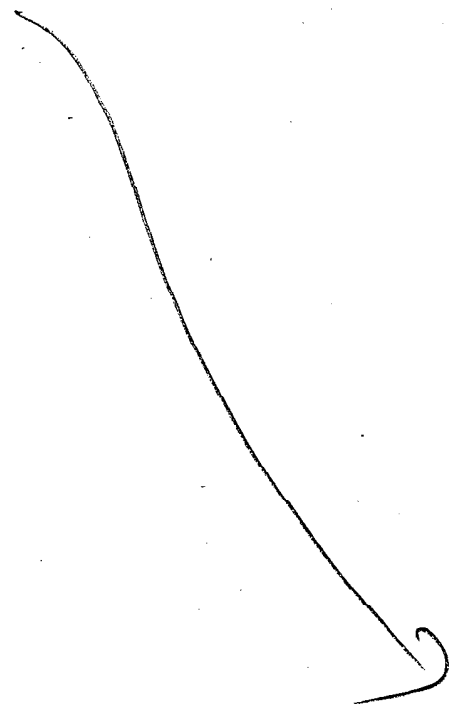

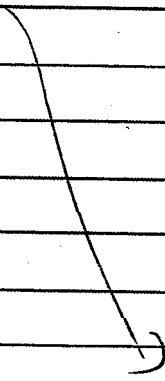
