Lift the current cap on the amount the DNR can pay for purchases of land in Chiwaukee Prairie (Pleasant Prairie). The remaining properties that have not been purchased under the Stewardship fund are Lake Michigan frontage properties. Apparently there was an informal agreement DNR had with Gov. Thompson that these properties would be vetoed if they paid more than \$6000. These remaining lakefront properties are worth well more than that (average estimate is \$11,000). Motion #1356 failed on a party-line, 8-8 vote. No fiscal effect.

The Nature Conservancy supports Senator Wirch's motion to continue the protection of Chiwaukee Prairie in Kenosha County. The Conservancy has been working with the Village of Pleasant Prairie, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, UW-Parkside and many local citizens for over 30 years to protect the prairie along the Lake Michigan shoreline.

Senator Wirch's motion # 1356 will remove an obstacle that has prevented acquisition by the DNR of some parcels in their portion of the project and will help maintain the important partnership between the state, the Village of Pleasant Prairie, citizens and private conservation groups.

This cooperative project is working patiently to protect one of the most diverse prairie remnants in the entire upper Midwest by acquiring land from willing landowners in often times very small parcels. In the last 30 years, working together, over 300 acres of prairie have been protected for future generations. Because of the high natural diversity, Chiwaukee Prairie has been designated a National Natural Landmark by the US Department of the Interior. Chiwaukee Prairie also provides important open space for citizens in a rapidly urbanizing part of the state.

This motion will require the DNR to use fair market appraisals in their land acquisition at Chiwaukee Prairie.
