- Modify previous action of Joint Finance on district attorneys (motion 1058 Burke/Kaufert/Huber) by reallocating a 0.5 assistant district attorney position for Ashland County from one or more of the counties funded by Joint Finance but ranked lower in need than Ashland County.
- Fund this position by taking a 0.5 position from some combination of counties lower in need than Ashland County.
- Cost: because the 0.5 position would be taken from counties already allocated a position by Joint Finance, this proposal has no cost in addition to the JFC version of the bill.
- As shown by the attached chart from paper 381, Ashland County ranks 6th in need at a current prosecutor workload of 140%, yet Joint Finance gave new positions to 8 counties ranked lower in need than Ashland County.

Move to provide that: (a) when the cumulative amount retained by a county for fines and forfeitures imposed by the courts under Chapters 341 through 347, 349 and 351 is equal to the amount retained by the county for such fines and forfeitures in 2000-01, the county must remit 100% of such fines and forfeitures that exceed the amount retained by the county in 2000-01 to the State Treasurer, who shall distribute 50% of these funds to the common school fund and 50% to a district attorney fines and forfeitures program revenue appropriation; and (b) create a district attorney fines and forfeitures program revenue appropriation that would receive these funds and provide that these funds could be used to support the costs of prosecutors.




