I have a few questions on this draft and I'm hoping you can provide some guidance:

1. The motion uses "sign", singular. It may be the intent to have the sign on only one side of the freeway, but this seems a little odd. Should I use "sign" or "signs" in the draft, and if the latter, should I specify the number of signs?
2. Should I include language that DOT may not charge a fee for erection of the sign(s), or should erection of signs be upon application and payment of the standard fee if any?
3. Should I require the signs to be erected within the biennium?
