Related Fiscal Bureau papers and motions:

Description: Require DOT to construct a noise barrier along the eastern side of I-94, at the College Avenue northbound on-ramp in Milwaukee County. Require the Department to allocate funds from the STH rehabilitation program to pay for this installation.

Fiscal effect: The department currently allocates \$1 million annually out of its rehabilitation budget for what are called retrofit noise barriers along existing state highways and freeways. This amendment would require the department to construct the College Avenue on-ramp project from those funds.
