Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the secretary of natural resources is nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, to serve at the pleasure of the governor. Under this bill, the natural resources board appoints the secretary of natural resources.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.05 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.05 (1) (b) Except as provided in pars. (c) and par. (d), if a department is under the direction and supervision of a board, the board shall appoint a secretary to serve at the pleasure of the board outside the classified service. In such departments, the powers and duties of the board shall be regulatory, advisory, and policy—making, and not administrative. All of the administrative powers and duties of the department

Fiscal Effect: This proposal would have no fiscal impact.



Under current law, the Secretary of Natural Resources and the members of the Natural Resources Board are appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The Secretary serves at the pleasure of the Governor and the members of the board serve for staggered 6-year terms. The Secretary is the administrative head of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), and the Board performs the regulatory, advisory and policy-making duties for DNR.

This proposal will remove the power of appointment of the Secretary from the Governor and return it to the Natural Resources Board. The Secretary would be appointed without the advice and consent of the Senate and serve at the pleasure of the board. This proposal allows the current Secretary of Natural Resources to continue to serve until he or she vacates his or her office or is removed from office by the Board.

Note: This proposal was introduced as 1999 Senate Bill 27.
