At your request, this memorandum provides background information on the process of approving a project for construction under the major highway development program and provides the text of a budget motion that would require DOT to conduct a study of STH 11/USH 14 between Janesville and I-43.

DOT is prohibited from constructing a major highway development project, which, in general terms is a highway expansion project longer than five miles, unless the project is enumerated in the statutes. DOT is also prohibited from conducting an environmental impact statement (EIS) or environmental assessment (EA), which are generally required by state and federal laws, before receiving the approval of the Transportation Projects Commission (TPC). Not later than October 15 of each odd-numbered year, DOT must present a list of potential projects to the TPC for consideration by the Commission and potential approval for the preparation of an EIS or EA. The TPC notifies DOT of which projects are approved for such an EIS or EA by the following April 15 (each even-numbered year), at which time DOT may proceed with the study of those approved projects.

DOT must make recommendations to the TPC for adjustments to the list of enumerated projects not later than September 15 of each even-numbered year and the TPC must make recommendations on any changes to the list not later than December 15. DOT's practice is to complete an EIS, which generally takes about one to two years to complete, prior to presenting projects for consideration for enumeration to the TPC. Consequently, projects that are approved for an EIS in April of an even-numbered year would not be ready for consideration for enumeration in that year, but instead, would generally be considered two years after the initial approval.

Your motion would require a study of transportation options for the STH 11/USH 14 corridor between Janesville and I-43, but would not require an EIS. If the study's recommendation is to construct the project as a major highway development project, DOT would be required to present the project for the TPC for consideration in 2004. In order to allow DOT to conduct an EIS for the project in time for consideration in 2002, the motion would exempt the project from the requirement that the TPC approve the project for an EIS.

The text of your proposed motion follows:

Move to require DOT to conduct a study of the transportation corridor between Janesville and I-43 along STH 11 and USH 14. Specify that the study shall develop and evaluate various alternatives for improving the capacity and safety of transportation in the corridor. Specify that DOT shall consult with local units of governments on the study design and methodology and shall cooperate with the City of Janesville, Rock County and Walworth County in the completion of the study. Specify that if the study's recommended solution for improvements in the corridor involve construction of a major highway development project on STH 11/USH 14, the Department shall present this project for consideration by the Transportation Projects Commission (TPC) when the Commission meets to consider potential projects for enumeration as a major highway development project in 2003. 


