17 appropriations to implement such act. The plan shall require that the amount of any
18 proposed reductions from program revenue, program revenue–service, or segregated
19 fund revenue–service appropriations lapse to the transportation fund. If the
20 cochairpersons of the committee do not notify the department of transportation that
21 the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the proposed
22 plan within 14 working days after the date of the submittal, the department of
23 transportation may implement the plan. If, within 14 days after the date of the
24 submittal, the cochairpersons of the committee notify the department of

1 transportation that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of
2 reviewing the proposed plan, the department of transportation may not implement
3 the plan until it is approved by the committee, as submitted or as modified.”
