They want the Committee to report to the Governor and Legislature (I suggested this instead of JFC since it would require legislation). They want an online reported within 6 months and a full plan reported within 1 year that indicates.....(may want to talk to her about exactly what she wants to include)

She does NOT want to eliminate the fee increase that was proposed by the Gov - she didn't understand that this was not being used to fund electronic systems.

4 January 1, 2002, the secretary of health and family services shall appoint a
5 committee to develop recommended guidelines for an on-line electronic filing system
6 for vital records in Wisconsin that incorporates privacy, flexibility, and productivity;
7 to study methods employed by other states to protect against identity theft in on-line
8 electronic filing systems; to recommend increases, if necessary, in vital records fees
9 for implementation of an on-line electronic filing system; and to recommend

1 allocation of revenues resulting from the fee increases. The members of the
2 committee shall include all of the following:

3 1. The state registrar of vital statistics.

4 2. Three local registrars, including one from a county with a population that
5 does not exceed 4,000,000; one from a county with a population that exceeds
6 4,000,000 but does not exceed 21,000,000; and one from a county with a population
7 that exceeds 21,000,000.

8 3. Three representatives of the department of health and family services.

9 4. One genealogist.

10 5. One representative of the department of electronic government.

11 (b) By July 1, 2002, the committee appointed under paragraph (a) shall develop
12 an outline of its proposals.

13 (c) By January 1, 2003, the committee appointed under paragraph (b) shall
14 report its findings and recommendations, including a proposed schedule of fees
15 chargeable for vital records that supports implementation of an on-line electronic
16 filing system and security measures to protect against identity theft, to the
17 legislature in the manner provided under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes and to the
18 governor.”
