CAUCUS SENATE AMENDMENT

TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 484, line 24: delete lines 24 and 25 and substitute:

3 “29.184 (4) (c) 1. A person may train a dog under sub. (3) (br) 3. only in the
4 northern portion of the state and only during the period beginning on July 1 and
5 ending on August 31 of each year.

6 2. For purposes of subd. 1, the northern portion of the state consists of the area
7 that lies northward of a line beginning at Lake Michigan that follows the Oconto
8 River upstream to where it reaches USH 41, that then runs northward along USH
9 41 until it intersects STH 22, that then runs westward along STH 22 to the city of
10 Shawano, that then runs westward from the city of Shawano along STH 29 until it

1 reaches STH 13, that then runs northward along STH 13 until it reaches STH 64,
2 that then runs westward along STH 64 until it reaches USH 53, that then runs
3 northwestward along USH 53 until it reaches USH 8, and that then runs westward
4 along USH 8 until it reaches the Mississippi River.”

5 **2.** Page 485, line 25: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
6 with page 486, line 17.

29.184 (4) (c) A person may train a dog under sub. (3) (br) 3. only during the period beginning on July 1 and ending on August 31 of each year.

SECTION 1165r. 29.184 (4) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

29.184 (4) (c) A person hunting bear with a pack of dogs or using a pack of dogs while engaging in any of the activities specified in sub. (3) (br) 1. to 3. under the authority of a Class A bear license may not have more than 6 dogs in the pack. The person may replace a dog in the pack with another dog at any time.

SECTION 1165w. 29.184 (5) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

29.184 (5) (d) A person holding a valid license issued under s. 29.512 who accompanies and assists a holder of valid Class A bear license may engage in the activities authorized under sub. (3) (br) 1. to 3. without holding a Class B bear license."

12 **SECTION 1171n.** 29.335 of the statutes is created to read:

13 **29.335 Baiting of wild animals for hunting and dog training purposes.**

14 (1) In this section, "undisturbed carrion" means carrion of a wild animal that has
15 not been moved by humans from the place where the wild animal died except to the
16 degree necessary to field dress the wild animal.

17 (2) (a) Except as provided in par. (b), no person may use honey, bones, fish,
18 meat, or solid animal fat or parts of dead animals for the purpose of hunting or for
19 the purpose of training dogs to track, trail, or otherwise locate wild animals. The
20 department may not otherwise restrict or prohibit the types of bait used for any of
21 these purposes.

22 (b) A person who is hunting coyote, fox, raccoon, or any wild animal for which
23 there is no closed season or who is training dogs to track, trail, or otherwise locate
24 coyote, fox, raccoon, or any wild animal for which there is no closed season may use
25 undisturbed carrion as bait."

Bear Hunting

Motion:

Move to provide \$24,000 annually from the fish and wildlife account of the conservation fund for DNR to contract for a wildlife biologist position at the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point College of Natural Resources. Further, provide \$24,000 annually and 1.0 PR position annually at the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point College of Natural Resources for this purpose.

In addition, specify that a person or persons hunting or pursuing bear with a pack of dogs may not have more than six dogs in the pack regardless of dog ownership, but allow dogs to be replaced at any time.

Statutorily designate that there are no hunting hour restrictions for pursuing coyote, fox, raccoon and all wild animals for which no closed season is established (except for coyotes during an open season for hunting deer with firearms in an area that is closed by DNR by rule to coyote hunting) under statute, that it would be permitted to hunt coyote, fox, raccoon and all wild animals for which no closed season is established over naturally occurring carrion.

Designate that the DNR administrative rule establishing zones where dogs may be trained or used for hunting be specified under statute. From May 1 through June 30, individuals may not hunt or pursue any free-roaming wild animal with the aid of dog or dogs in the portion of the state north of the highways shown in Figure 1, except for dog trials and training under permit, or on the premises of licensed game farms, fur farms, and shooting preserves or on any private land when license holders used licensed animals for dog trials. Designate that the DNR administrative rules specifying types of legal bait used for the purpose of hunting or training dogs be specified under statute. Use of bait is permitted, with the only exception of attracting wild animals using honey, bones, fish, meat, solid animal fat or parts of animal carcasses. The training of dogs by pursuing wild bear is limited to July 1 through August 31 in the portion of the state north of the highways shown in Figure 1.

Finally, eliminate the requirement for a licensed bear guide to acquire a class B bear pursuit license while assisting a licensed bear hunter.

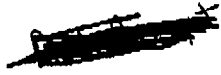
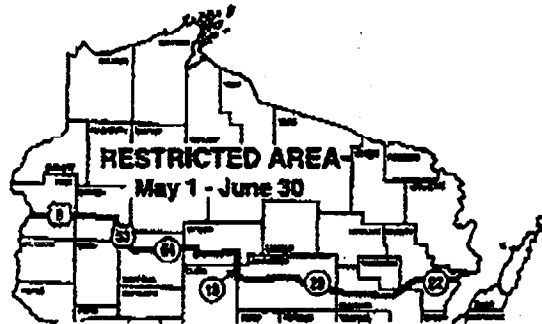

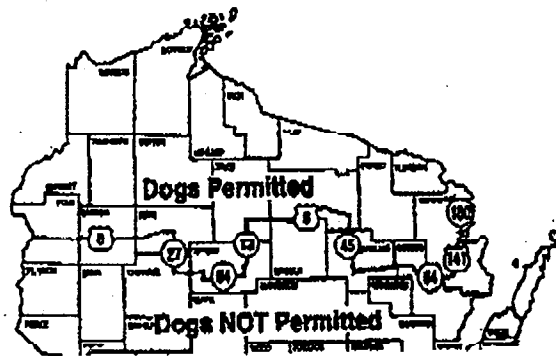

Note:

The position funded would be a University of Wisconsin employee. Any funding for the position in excess of the \$24,000 annually would be the responsibility of the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point. The language establishing zones where dogs generally may not be trained or used for hunting between May 1 and June 30 is listed under NR 10.07(1)(i), 17.01(3), 17.01(1) and (2). The language specifying types of legal bait used for the purpose of hunting or training dogs can be found under NR 10.07(1)(g)2. The language specifying regulations applicable to bear hunting with dogs is listed under 10.01 (3)(g). The requirement that a licensed bear guide must possess a Class B bear pursuit license may be found under s.29.184(3)(br) and 29.184(3)(br)1.
