offered by a University of Wisconsin two-year college campus. The bill eliminates the requirement that the participant work for 25 hours per week and limits the number of hours a W-2 agency may require the participant to work or participate in other activities to 25 hours per week.

The bill prohibits a W-2 agency from requiring a participant in unsubsidized employment, a community service job, or transitional placement to participate in activities that interfere with the participant's education or training activities, high school attendance, or participation in a self-initiated education program.

Finally, the bill permits an individual who participates in both unsubsidized employment and the technical college education program to receive a monthly cash grant that is prorated according to the number of hours he or she participates in a self-initiated education program.


