**Motion:**

Move to allow Wisconsin racetrack licensees to retain unclaimed winnings and the 0.75% general program operations assessment currently paid to the state.

---

**Note:**

Under current law, all winnings on a race that are not claimed within 90 days of the end of a racing year are credited to appropriations for the general program operations for racing regulation in the Department of Administration (DOA) and for racing law enforcement in the Department of Justice (DOJ). In addition, racetrack licensees must remit to DOA 0.75% of the total amount wagered within 48 hours of each race day. These revenues are also credited to the appropriations for racing regulation in DOA and racing law enforcement in DOJ. Any unencumbered balances in these appropriations at the end of each fiscal year are transferred to the lottery fund and must be used for property tax relief.

Under the motion, unclaimed winnings and the 0.75% assessment would be retained by the racetrack licensees and state revenue would decrease by these amounts. State revenue decreases under the motion are estimated as follows: (a) unclaimed winnings, -\$722,300 in 2001-02 and -\$693,000 in 2002-03; and (b) 0.75% assessment, -\$1,017,000 in 2001-02 and -\$975,800 in 2002-03.

SUBJECT: Proposal Relating to Racetrack Retention of Unclaimed Winnings and a General Program Operations Assessment

Following is the information you requested on your proposal to allow Wisconsin racetrack licensees to retain unclaimed winnings and the 0.75% general program operations assessment currently paid to the state.

Under current law, all winnings on a race that are not claimed within 90 days of the end of a racing year are credited to appropriations for the general program operations for racing regulation in the Department of Administration (DOA) and for racing law enforcement in the Department of Justice (DOJ). In addition, racetrack licensees must remit to DOA 0.75% of the total amount wagered within 48 hours of each race day. These revenues are also credited to the appropriations for racing regulation in DOA and racing law enforcement in DOJ. Any unencumbered balances in these appropriations at the end of each fiscal year are transferred to the lottery fund and must be used for property tax relief.

Under your proposal, unclaimed winnings and the 0.75% assessment would be retained by the racetrack licensees and state revenue would decrease by these amounts. The following table shows the actual 1999-00 revenue and the projected revenue in 2000-01, 2001-02 and 2002-03 relating to unclaimed winnings and the 0.75% assessment:

6 3. Page 377, line 4: after that line insert:

7 “SECTION 764qy. 20.455 (2) (fm) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 20.455 (2) (fm) *Gaming law enforcement*. The amounts in the schedule for the  
9 performance of the department’s gaming law enforcement responsibilities as

1 specified in s. 165.70 (3m). ~~No moneys may be encumbered or expended from this~~  
2 ~~appropriation account after the day of publication of the 2001–03 biennial budget~~

4 **SECTION 764r.** 20.455 (2) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

16 **SECTION 879r.** 20.505 (8) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

17 20.505 (8) (g) *General program operations; racing.* The amounts in the  
18 schedule for general program operations under ch. 562. All moneys received by the  
19 department of administration under s. 562.065 (4), 1999 stats., and ss. 562.02 (2) (f),  
20 562.04 (1) (b) 4. and (2) (d), 562.05 (2), 562.065 (3) (cm) and (d), (3m) (c) 2. ~~and (4)~~,  
21 562.09 (2) (e) and 562.124 (2), less the amounts appropriated under s. 20.455 (2) (g),  
22 shall be credited to this appropriation account. Notwithstanding s. 20.001 (3) (a), the  
23 unencumbered balance of this appropriation account at the end of each fiscal year  
24 shall be transferred to the lottery fund.”.

2           “**SECTION 3713jm.** 562.065 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

4           ~~any~~ any winnings on a race ~~which~~ that are not claimed within 90 days after the end of  
5           the period authorized for racing in that year under s. 562.05 (9) ~~shall be paid to the~~  
6           ~~department. The department shall credit moneys received under this subsection to~~  
7           ~~the appropriation accounts under ss. 20.455 (2) (g) and 20.505 (8) (g).”.~~

8           **6.** Page 1394, line 5: after that line insert:

9           “(3c) UNCLAIMED PRIZES. The treatment of section 562.065 (4) of the statutes  
10           first applies to prizes that are unclaimed on the 90th day after the effective date of  
11           this subsection.”.

12           **7.** Page 1416, line 25: after that line insert:

13           “(3q) UNCLAIMED PRIZES. The treatment of sections 20.455 (2) (fm) and (g),  
14           20.505 (8) (b) and (g), and 562.065 (4) of the statutes and SECTION 9301 (3c) of this  
15           act take effect on July 1, 2002.”.
