The motion would provide ~~\$200,000~~ in federal TANF funds in 2001-02 to the Northwest Side Community Development Corporation to conduct a job training program for TANF-eligible individuals at the old Tower Automotive site in Milwaukee. The new employer at the site will be Pressed Steel Tank, which is a manufacturer of steel cylinders. It is anticipated that 100 jobs would be transferred to the site and 50 new jobs would be created. The job training funds would be used for the 50 new jobs being created. The motion would specify that no funds could be distributed unless DWD determines that the use of funds is an eligible use under the TANF block grant.
