AN ACT to amend 21.49 (2) (d), 21.49 (3) (b) 3. and 21.49 (3m); and to create 20.465 (2) (g), 21.49 (2) (c), 21.49 (2) (f), 21.49 (4) (c), 21.49 (4) (d) and 71.93 (1) (a) 6. of the statutes; relating to: national guard tuition reimbursement grants and making an appropriation.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain national guard members are eligible for a tuition grant equal to 100% of actual tuition charged (up to the maximum resident undergraduate tuition charged by the University of Wisconsin-Madison) upon satisfactory completion of a full-time or part-time course in a qualifying school. Currently, qualifying schools include the extension division and any campus of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System, a technical college, and any accredited institution of higher education in this state. National guard members who are not eligible to receive a tuition grant include officers, individuals with a baccalaureate degree, and members who have failed to meet national guard service eligibility criteria. Under current law, the department of military affairs (DMA) may require a person to repay a tuition grant if the person fails, within 12 months of receipt of the grant, to meet any of the national guard service eligibility criteria.

Under this bill, additional national guard members are not eligible for a tuition grant, including a member who has been in the U.S. armed forces, including the national guard, for ten years or more, a member who is absent without leave for more than nine unit training assemblies, and a member who has failed to achieve a grade point average of 2.0 or more or an average grade of "C" for the classes for which

The bill restricts persons who join the national guard after the effective date of the bill to attendance at the technical college system and the UW System and to attendance at any institution of higher education covered by the Minnesota-Wisconsin reciprocity agreement. That same restriction is added to the bill for every national guard member after June 30, 2005. The bill requires the DMA to require a person to repay a tuition grant if the person is separated from the national guard for misconduct. The bill permits DMA to collect the tuition grant repayment through the state tax intercept program.


