- We will be asking the Department of Commerce to promulgate rules establishing voluntary guidelines relating to the design, construction, installation and use of nighttime outdoor light fixtures. The guidelines shall include provisions to achieve specific goals for energy conservation for nighttime lighting which are spelled out in the draft. (WLC 0096/1 is attached).

(4) The department shall consult with the department of administration regarding the outdoor light fixtures and lamps used in outdoor light fixtures for state buildings and facilities. The department of administration shall comply with the guidelines under sub. (1) to the extent practicable.

Notwithstanding s. 101.86(1)(a),

(5) A city, village, town or county may enact and enforce standards for outdoor lighting that are similar to the guidelines under sub. (1) or may enact and enforce standards for outdoor

lighting that are less or more restrictive than the guidelines under sub. (1). A city, village, town or county may apply its standards to outdoor light fixtures and lamps for outdoor light fixtures

constructed or installed before the effective date of the city, village, town or county standards.

SECTION 3. 895.59 of the statutes is created to read:

3871c
895.59 Liability exemption; outdoor lighting. Outdoor lighting may not be found to be a nuisance or trespass if all of the following apply:

(1) The outdoor lighting complies with the guidelines ^{promulgated} under sub. (1). *s. 101.815*

(2) The outdoor lighting meets the requirements for ^{self-}certification under sub. (2).
