Require that Corrections, as part of its integrated corrections system, publish statistics related to adult corrections on its internet web site which include at a minimum: (a) the total prison population; (b) prison population by institution; (c) commitments to the correctional system; (d) release from the correctional system; (e) admissions to the correctional system; (f) average sentence length; (g) offenses; (h) race; (i) educational level; (j) marital status; (k) parental status; (l) religion; and (m) county of commitment. Require that Corrections, as part of its integrated corrections system, publish statistics related to juvenile corrections on its internet web site which include at a minimum: (a) the total population; (b) population by institution; (c) gender; (d) race; (e) average age; (f) offenses; (g) county of commitment; (g) admissions; (h) releases; (i) average population; and (n) commitments.
