Domestic Violence--1% of TANF for Sexual Assault

Agency: DWD and DOJ

CN6516

Description: Creates a grant program for services for victims of childhood sexual assault and for the prevention of childhood sexual assault to be administered by DOJ. DOJ must establish eligibility criteria to be used in deciding whether to award a grant under this proposal. Proposal allocates 1% of temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) block grant funding in each fiscal year for these grants and requires DWD to transfer this amount to the appropriation created to fund these grants.

Fiscal Effect: \$6.35 Million TANF (\$3,175,000 in 2001-02 and \$3,175,000 in 2002-03)
(The annual temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) block grant is currently \$317.5 million in Wisconsin.)

1 **AN ACT** to amend 20.445 (3) (md); and to create 20.455 (5) (kv), 49.175 (1) (zv)

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau
