Legislative Fiscal Bureau Budget Summary, Page 449, Item #3

I oppose the governor's recommendation to require the Department of Military Affairs (DMA) to reduce the agency's largest GPR state operations appropriation by 5-percent. In previous action, the Joint Finance Committee voted to reduce the GPR appropriation for the National Guard Tuition Grant Program by \$1,406,300 GPR, an amount that is twice the required 5-percent reduction.

Further reductions to the agency will jeopardize the agency's ability to successfully operate the National Guard Youth Programs, in particular the Badger Challenge program, which is very successful at diverting at-risk youth from the corrections system, keeping them in school, and ultimately obtaining a high school diploma or GED.
