1       **AN ACT** to create 20.435 (5) (g) and 146.65 of the statutes: relating to: funding for  
2       the rural health dental clinic and making an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE:** This draft, prepared for the special committee on dental care access, provides \$294,460 general purpose revenue (GPR) in fiscal year 2001–2002 and \$355,600 GPR in fiscal year 2002–2003 to the rural health dental clinic in Menomonie. The rural health dental clinic's primary source of funds, a federal rural health outreach grant, expires on September 1, 2001 and currently provides the clinic with \$250,000 per year in operating expenses.

The draft provides \$208,500 GPR (five-sixths of the amount of the \$250,000 expiring federal grant) for the 10 months from September 2001 to June 2002. An additional \$87,960 GPR is provided to fund 10 months of salary and benefits for one additional dentist to expand the clinic's services to a site in Pepin county, for a total of \$294,460 GPR for 2001–2002. For fiscal year 2002–2003, the draft provides \$250,000 GPR to replace the expired federal funds, plus \$105,600 GPR additional for the dentist's salary and benefits for a total of \$355,600 GPR.

The figures for the dentist's salary are based on an annual salary of \$80,000 plus an additional 32% for fringe benefits. The draft also requires the department to seek federal funds to support the operations of the rural health dental clinic.

 11 department shall allocate not more than \$294,460 in fiscal year 2001-2002 and \$355,600 in  
 12 fiscal year 2002-2003 to the rural health dental clinic located in Menomonie that provides  
 13 mobile dental services to persons in the counties of Barron, Chippewa, Dunn, Pepin, Pierce,  
 14 Polk and St. Croix who are developmentally disabled, elderly or low-income. The department  
 15 shall also seek federal funding to support the operations of the rural health dental clinic.

16 SECTION 4. **Effective date.** This act takes effect on the 2nd day after publication of the  
 17 2001-03 biennial budget act

8 Dunn, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, and St. Croix.

9 (2) The department shall also seek federal funding to support the operations  
10 of the rural health dental clinics under sub. (1).”.

13 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health and family  
14 services under section 20.435 (5) (dm) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001,  
15 the dollar amount is increased by \$294,500 for fiscal year 2001–02 and the dollar  
16 amount is increased by \$355,600 for fiscal year 2002–03 to increase funding for the  
17 rural health dental clinic in Menomonie.
