“(74) NOISE ATTENUATION BARRIER IN MILWAUKEE COUNTY; I 94 AT GRANGE AVENUE.”

4 The department of transportation shall install a noise attenuation barrier along the
5 west side of I 94 from the intersection of I 94 and Grange Avenue and extending to
6 the south, in Milwaukee County. The department shall expend funds not to exceed
7 \$200,000 from the appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (cq), (cv), and (cx) of the
8 statutes, as affected by this act, for the installation required under this subsection.”.
