Include the Building Commission recommendation to a) enumerate \$131.5 million in self-amortizing bonding to contract for construction of the Wisconsin History Center; b) specify that the Building Commission would not be allowed to issue the self-amortizing bonding until commitments of at least \$75 million from gifts, grants, or other receipts to finance the structure; c) modify the Society's existing program revenue debt services appropriation to also receive revenues from the Society's gifts and grants appropriation; and d) specify that the Society's existing self-amortizing bonding authorization for acquisition, construction, development, enlargement, and improvement of facilities at the state historic sites could not be used for construction of the Wisconsin History Center.
