Amendment: Allocate \$100,000 to Beloit College from the Indian gaming receipts
appropriation to support a two-year effort to educate school children and
adults in southern Wisconsin about Native American cultures.

Explanation: The funds will pay the salary and benefits of an education curator at the
Logan Museum of Anthropology and other costs associated with
programs for school groups and development of educational materials.
The College will seek additional funds for continuation of the programs
beyond the two-year start-up period.

The Logan Museum of Anthropology was founded in 1893 with the gift
of 3,000 Native American artifacts exhibited at the Chicago Columbian
Exposition earlier that year. In the subsequent 108 years, the collection
has grown to include more than 200,000 specimens. Thanks to a \$4
million renovation in 1995, the Museum is now a state-of-the-art facility
for the conservation and exhibition of materials about cultures
worldwide.

Special areas of strength include the Native American collections,
particularly those of the Great Lakes and Plains regions. The new
director of the Museum (Ph.D., UW-Madison) is a specialist in Native
American cultures of this area.

In order to accommodate a significantly increased number of visitors,
both via school groups and the general public, and in order to make these
visits as educationally rewarding as possible, an education curator is
needed to develop materials and work with groups both before and
during their visits. The education curator hired will coordinate with
tribal educators in developing programs and materials of value to school
groups. Tribal involvement will help the students and other visitors learn
that Wisconsin's rich Native heritage continues today in living
communities.
