**Summary** 

Under current law, the state imposes a tax on the gross earnings of a car line company at a rate of 3%, in lieu of imposing property taxes. Railroad companies are currently assessed the personal property tax at a rate of 2.2%.

X

This amendment would establish a more equitable tax structure for railroad companies and car line companies and car line companies, by reducing the car line company gross earnings tax from 3% to 2.5%.

**Fiscal Impact** 

The Department of Revenue estimates loss of revenue to be approximately \$100,000 annually. The amendment appropriates \$100,000 SEG from mass transit in 2001-2002 and \$100,000 in 2002-2003 to fund this decrease in the car line company gross earnings tax.

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
