Summary Currently, the capital assistance program exists to promote the general public health and welfare by providing capital assistance to eligible applicants providing transportation services to elderly and disabled persons.

This amendment directs DOT to earmark \$30,000 from the capital assistance program for the purchase of an elderly transportation bus to serve two municipalities in Kenosha County, including the Village of Twin Lakes and the Town of Randall.
