2. Is it correct that the funding for Oneida and Vilas Counties is for cooperative law enforcement with the Lac du Flambeau tribe, and the funding for Forest County is for cooperation with the Potawatomi (Mole Lake reservation)?
3. When should the funding be disbursed? should it be disbursed evenly over both years of the biennium?
4. Should any unused funding revert to the Indian gaming appropriation account at the end of the biennium.
