Statement of Intent This amendment deletes the purchase of 72 additional vehicles for state agencies. It does not affect the 24 vehicles designated for the Department of Corrections.

The amendment also requires the purchase of only four-door subcompact vehicles.

Summary Under current law, DOA operates a vehicle fleet for state agencies. As such, the Department purchases or leases the vehicles and makes them available through either the pool of vehicles for use by state employees or assignment to state agencies. In cases where the state agencies request their own vehicles, they must receive DOA approval before they can purchase or lease automobiles for agency use.

The amendment does the following:

1. Delete the purchase of 72 additional vehicles for state agencies. This number does not include 24 vehicles designated for DOC.
2. Require DOA, DNR, DOT, and UW-Madison to purchase or lease only four-door subcompact passenger vehicles instead of four-door compact passenger vehicles. The amendment further specifies that when making requests for vehicles, all agencies are required to delineate by model what kinds of vehicles they are requesting.

Fiscal Impact The elimination of the purchase of 72 additional vehicles to the state fleet would eliminate approximately \$1.5M (PR) for DOA.

Note: DOA borrows to make the fleet purchase, and retires the debt through PR charged to agencies using the fleet service.

Summary The State Transportation Services budget calls for purchasing and supporting 96 additional vehicles for state agencies over the biennium.

This amendment eliminates funding for additional state vehicle purchases. State trooper squad cars are excluded from this provision.

The amendment does not affect the provision for replacement of existing vehicles and aircraft overhaul.

Fiscal Impact Eliminate \$2,132,500 (PR) as follows:

1. One-time \$792,400 for 44 vehicles in 2001-02
2. One-time \$921,100 for 52 vehicles in 2002-03
3. Associated maintenance, fuel and insurance costs (\$132,900 in 2001-02 and \$286,100 in 2002-03).
