Reserve judge requirement (1999 AB 826)

This bill prohibits the appointment of any person as a reserve judge if that person was defeated at the most recent time that he or she sought election to a circuit court judgeship.

Fair employment (2001 AB 186)

Permitting an employer to refuse to employ or to terminate from employment an individual whas been convicted of a felony and who has not been pardoned.

Drug Dealer Liability (LRB 2602/P2)

Send to Art. 2

Creating liability for a person involved in the distribution, possession or sale of illegal drugs.

Sex offenders working with children (1999 AB 284)

Prohibit child sex offenders from working or volunteering with children and providing a penalty.

Civil forfeitures for chiminal acts (1999 SB 78)

Remove part of the state statute pertaining to 165.10 Civil rights enforcement. If any person, whether or not acting under color of law, interferes with the exercise or enjoyment by any individual of a right secured by the constitution or laws of the United States, or of a right secured by the constitution or laws of this state, the attorney general may bring an action for injunction or other appropriate equitable relief to protect the peaceable exercise or enjoyment of the right secured. #### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the chief justice of the supreme court may appoint former supreme court justices, court of appeal judges or circuit judges to serve as reserve judges. In addition, the chief justice of the supreme court may appoint a person to serve as a reserve judge if the person was eligible to serve as a reserve judge before May 1, 1992. Reserve judges are appointed to assist the supreme court in the administration of justice, and perform the same duties as a regular judge, usually on a temporary basis.

This bill prohibits the appointment of any person as a reserve judge if that person was defeated at the most recent time that he or she sought election to a circuit court judgeship.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION X. 753.075 (2) (a) and (b) of the statutes are amended to read:

753.075 (2) (a) Any person who has served a total of 6 or more years as a
