Summary This motion establishes a Crime Prevention Resource Center provided the following requirements are complied with (a) the center is administered by a Wisconsin System Technical College with a pre-existing building with a pre-existing curriculum in police science; (b) the center is housed in a pre-existing building with space available without displacing existing staff or programs; (c) the floor space allocated for the Crime Prevention Resource Center within the host facility is a minimum of 180 square feet and no more than 190 square feet at the time of establishment; (d) the host technical college operates the facility with 0.5 FTE for the 2001-2003 fiscal budget years; (e) the host technical college transfers out-year budget requirements to the Crime Prevention Resource Center's administrative authority; (f) the administrative authority is the Wisconsin Crime Prevention Practitioners Association.

Fiscal Impact This motion is funded by deleting \$27,000 SEG from the Minnesota -Wisconsin Boundary Area Commission; adding \$27,000 SEG to the Office of Justice Assistance; delete \$ 6,300 PR and \$56,700 FED from Federal Byrne Grants held by Office of Justice Assistance; add \$90,000 to Office of Justice Assistance Misdemeanor Diversion Program.

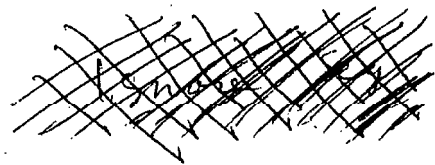
