Summary

The technical and occupational program was established to provide \$500 annual tuition grants to recent high school graduates to attend technical colleges.

This motion would eliminate the TOP grant program on July 1, 2002. It would reduce funding for TOP grants by \$400,000 GPR in 2001-02 to reflect a reestimate of program demand and by \$8,100,000 GPR in 2002-03, and completely eliminating program funding in 2002-03.

The capacity grant program would be eliminated on July 1, 2001 and delete \$3,000,000 GPR in 2001-02 and \$2,000,000 GPR in 2002-03.

The motion would also increase funding for additional course section grants by \$500,000 annually, from base funding of \$2,200,000. In addition, the motion provides a 1% annual increase for WTCS general aids, from base funding of \$118,415,000.

This motion was defeated in JFC on a 8-8 party line vote.


