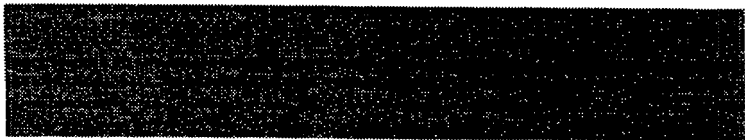

To the extent possible, the loans must be directed towards persons who are likely to work in the nursing profession In Wisconsin upon completion of their program and who demonstrate a financial need for the loan.</p> <p>The maximum amount of a loan that may be awarded under the program is set at \$3,000 and the total amount a person may receive is \$15,000. A loan recipient is not required to repay the loan while enrolled in a nursing program.</p> <p>After the recipient has completed the nursing program, the board is required to forgive 25% of the loan's principle and interest for the first fiscal year that the recipient is licensed and employed full-time in Wisconsin as a nurse. Similarly, the board must forgive 25 % of the loan's principle and interest for the second fiscal year. The board is authorized to forgive loans on a prorated basis for recipients employed less than full-time.</p> <p>Program would begin in fiscal year 2002-03.</p>	(\$450,000 GPR)
