Under current law, the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection provides financial assistance to owners of livestock herds for conducting testing for paratuberculosis (commonly called Johne's disease.)

This provision increases the funding for that financial assistance by \$400,000 in each fiscal year of the biennium.

Fiscal Impact: The Land Information Board currently has an annual appropriation of \$623,000 for general program operation for the development of a land information computer system. This would delete \$400,000 PR funds from the Land Information Board program out of 5051(ie) each fiscal year of the biennium and transfer these funds to 5051(if) PR. These funds would then be transferred to 5051(cm), making them GPR dollars. Transfer the \$400,000 GPR to DATCP 115(8) each fiscal year of the biennium to fund the Johne's Disease Testing program. Delete Joint Finance action. Return to Governor's position to provide \$118,200 in 2001-02 and \$121,200 in 2002-03 and 1.0 position from the agrichemical management fund to convert and expiring IPM specialist project position to permanent and provide additional contract funding to expand DATCP'S IPM assistance program in K-12 schools. The program assists public and private school staff in the use of IPM.

Fiscal Impact: Provide \$118,200 in 2001-02 and \$121,200 in 2002-03 and 1.0 position from the agrichemical management fund. Saves \$316,400 and 2.0 SEG positions over the biennium.

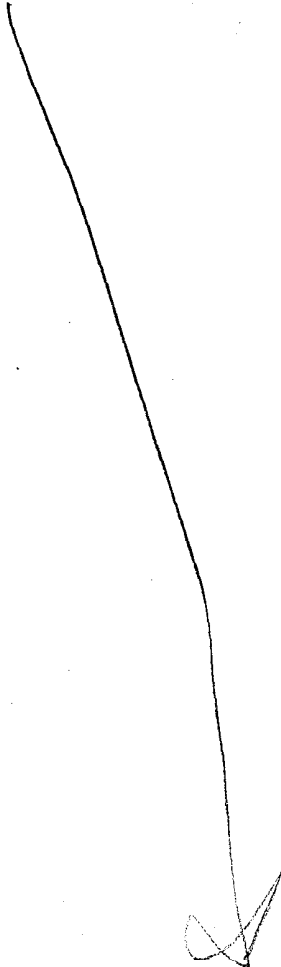
