


Lonnie,

I spoke with Dave about the funding for selected items in the UW economic stimulus package and he said that one of the Assembly members mentioned to him that it all of those items were new money and that it was not a base reallocation.

Therefore, we need a redraft to increase the 1(a) appropriation for each of the items listed in the draft. Also, I recommend changing the language regarding UW-Green Bay--currently you have that the funding must be used to fund a baccalaureate program at UW-GB with a 17:1 student ratio--I would change that because I don't think it would be possible for the UW System to achieve a 17:1 ratio with the amount of funding provided--I would say something like "to fund additional faculty and staff at UW Green Bay."
