

Summary The credit transfer issue has been a chronic problem that costs students and their families, taxpayers and the economy. Given the current labor shortage in many critical areas, the state should continue its aim toward a seamless higher-education system.

This amendment is a natural extension of the recent UW System and Technical School agreement that puts the burden of the credit transfer issue on the University, rather than on the students. Students now feel they have no recourse with the University's credit transfer decisions.

This amendment includes the following provisions:

1. If the UW System objects to an individual's transfer of credits, it has the option to petition to block individual cases. A favorable vote in both higher-education committees would be required to sustain the UW System's objection.
2. The transfer of credits would work in all directions involving four-year campuses, two-year campuses, and technical schools. For example, credits from a four-year program would be accepted at a tech school.
