Summary Currently, each legislator has his or her own toll free number which a citizen of Wisconsin can call 24 hours a day to speak with a legislator or to leave a message. The amendment would eliminate funding for the Legislative Hotline.

The general Legislative Hotline number is operated by the Sergeant-at-Arms office. The purpose of the Legislative Hotline is to take messages for the Legislators and to help citizens who call in to identify the Legislator who represents them by using the QMS software package. The annual breakdown of expenses is roughly \$500 to Ameritech, \$5,000 for services and toll-calls, \$20,000 for 1.5 FTE's.

In addition to eliminating funding for the Legislative Hotline, stipulate that the \$1.5 LTE positions would not be excluded from this amendment. Also, require every legislator publish their toll-free office number. Repeal the statutory language requiring the printing of the Legislative Hotline phone number on state maps. Finally, these provisions would be effective July 1, 2002.

Fiscal Impact According to the Assembly Chief Clerk, the elimination of the Legislative Hotline would reduce GPR spending by approximately \$52,167 over the biennium.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE RETENTION OF THE LTE POSITIONS WILL CHANGE THE FISCAL EFFECT.

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 ✓ 1. Page 9, line 19: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 102p. 13.205 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **13.205 Legislative hotline prohibited.** (1) Except as provided in sub. (2),
5 the joint committee on legislative organization, the assembly committee on
6 organization, and the senate committee on organization may not maintain a toll-free
7 telephone service for the use of members of the public to contact members of the
8 legislature or for the use of members of the legislature to contact members of the
9 public.

1 (2) An organization committee under sub. (1) may maintain or allow the
 2 maintenance of one toll-free telephone service per member of the legislature for the
 3 use of members of the public to contact the member of the legislature or for the use
 4 of the member of the legislature to contact members of the public. The senate
 5 committee on organization and the assembly committee on organization shall
 6 publish the number of the toll-free telephone service of each member of its house.”.

7 ✓ 2. Page 861, line 17: after that line insert:

8 “SECTION ^{NO CS} 2304P. 84.02 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 84.02 (5) (a) As often as it deems necessary, the department shall publish
 10 highway service maps showing the state trunk highway system and such other main
 11 highways and other features as may seem desirable. Such highway service maps
 12 shall be sold by the department at a price to be fixed by it, which shall be not less than
 13 cost. The department may permit the use of the base plates for other maps and
 14 publications in consideration of a fair fee for such use. The department shall make
 15 and publish or duplicate such highway service maps as are required for its use, and
 16 shall publish folded highway maps of Wisconsin for free distribution to the public.
 17 The department shall ensure that the folded highway maps bear information
 18 regarding the requirements of s. 347.48 (4) and do not bear information regarding
 19 toll-free telephone service under s. 13.205.”

20 ✓ 3. Page 1343, line 11: after that line insert:


21 (81) LEGISLATIVE HOTLINE POSITIONS. The authorized FTE positions for the
 22 assembly funded by the appropriation under section 20.765 (1)(a) of the statutes, as
 23 affected by this act, are decreased ^{ON} July 1, 2002, by 1.5 GPR positions to eliminate
 24 staffing of the legislative hotline.”

4. Page 1421, line 12: after that line insert:

“(1) LEGISLATIVE HOTLINE. The treatment of sections 13.205 and 84.02 (5) (a)
of the statutes take effect on July 1, 2002.”
