One primary goal of Assembly leadership is to provide opportunities for personal and professional development for Assembly staff. One way to achieve that goal is to sponsor "Staff Leadership Development Programs" for legislative staff.

The initial program was highly successful. Staff evaluation indicated strong support and interest in future Staff Leadership Development Programs. Many staff noted that other state training programs do not address the unique duties and responsibilities of a legislative office. The Staff Leadership Development Program provides information and discussion on topics such as public policy analysis, theory, public affairs, etc.

The Staff Leadership Development Programs are broken down into the following areas:

- 1. Assembly Staff Leadership Training
- 2. New Staff Training
- 3. LaFollette Capstone Program (staff receives a certificate upon the completion of four graduate level classes. Tuition is reimbursed at 75% of cost upon successful completion of the Capstone Program only.

In the current budget, the annual cost of all three education programs is \$38,000 (\$19,000 annually). The Governor's budget did not contain funding to continue the three programs.

This amendment would provide \$19,000 (\$9,500 annually) to fund the tuition reimbursement component of the Capstone Program only.

Funding for this amendment would come from eliminating the Out of Session Allowance paid to Legislators (Note: The allowance is only being paid to State Senators). The \$75 per month payment is an 'interim expense' made for each month in which the legislature is in session for three days or less.

Eliminating the Out of Session Allowance would reduce \$27,000 (GPR) in the biennium.

Fiscal Impact

A net reduction of \$8,000 (GPR) in the biennium.


