Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) administers programs relating to air quality, water quality, water supply, wastewater, recycling, solid and hazardous waste, mining, environmental cleanups, wetlands, shoreland zoning, navigable waters (including dams and piers), state parks and other recreational properties, forestry, the Stewardship Fund, the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway, wildlife (including hunting, fishing, and trapping), endangered resources, boats, snowmobiles, and all-terrain vehicles. DNR is governed by a seven-member board and has a secretary who is nominated by the governor, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed.

This bill divides DNR into two agencies: the department of fish, wildlife, parks, and forestry (DFWPF) and the department of environmental management (DEM).

The division takes effect on July 1, 2002.

Under the bill, DEM administers programs relating to air quality, water quality, water supply, wastewater, recycling, solid and hazardous waste, mining, environmental cleanups, wetlands, shoreland zoning, and navigable waters (including dams and piers). DFWPF administers programs relating to state parks and other recreational properties, forestry, the Stewardship Fund, the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway, wildlife (including hunting, fishing, and trapping), endangered resources, boats, snowmobiles, and all-terrain vehicles. Both agencies are governed by seven-member boards. Each board nominates and, with the approval of the governor, appoints the secretary of its department.

Under current law, DNR has seven division administrators who serve outside of the classified service. Under this bill, DEM has two division administrators and DFWPF has three division administrators, all of whom serve outside of the classified service. This bill also requires DFWPF to designate a chief warden, who serves outside of the classified service, to supervise conservation wardens; requires DFWPF to designate an internal affairs officer to investigate complaints against conservation wardens; and requires DFWPF to designate a complaint officer to resolve those complaints.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

Each conveyance shall contain a provision that such lands shall revert to the state when they are no longer used for national lakeshore purposes as defined by section 7 of the Apostle Islands national lakeshore act of 1970 (P.L. 91–424; 84 stat. 880), except that such reversion does not apply to lands upon which capital improvements have been placed by the United States.


