CAUCUS ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 1bg.** 1.026 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 1.026 (1) (b) It is the policy of the legislature that the Apostle Islands be
5 managed in a manner that will preserve their unique primitive and wilderness
6 character. The department of ~~natural resources~~ fish, wildlife, parks, and forestry is
7 directed before taking any action or making a decision concerning the Apostle
8 Islands to make a finding that such an action or decision will ensure that the citizens
9 of this state will be assured the opportunity for wilderness, inspirational primitive
10 and scenic experiences in the Apostle Islands into perpetuity.

1 **SECTION 1bh.** 1.026 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 1.026 (3) LANDS TO BE CONVEYED. Notwithstanding any other law to the
3 contrary, the department of ~~natural resources~~ fish, wildlife, parks, and forestry, with
4 the approval of the governor, is directed to donate and convey, upon request of the
5 United States for purposes of the development of the lakeshore, all state-owned
6 lands within the lakeshore boundary, as hereafter described: The state-owned lands
7 on Basswood, Oak, Michigan and Stockton Islands in township 50 north, range 3
8 west; township 51 north, range 1 west; township 51 north, range 3 west, township
9 52 north, range 3 west, all in the town of La Pointe, Ashland County, Wisconsin. Each
10 conveyance shall contain a provision that such lands shall revert to the state when
11 they are no longer used for national lakeshore purposes as defined by section 7 of the
12 Apostle Islands national lakeshore act of 1970 (P.L. 91-424; 84 stat. 880), except that
13 such reversion does not apply to lands upon which capital improvements have been
14 placed by the United States.

15 **SECTION 1bj.** 1.035 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

16 1.035 (1) The state of Wisconsin consents that the government of the United
17 States may acquire in this state, in any manner, such areas of land, or of land and
18 water, as the United States deems necessary for the establishment of the "Upper
19 Mississippi River Wildlife and Fish Refuge," in accordance with the act of congress
20 approved June 7, 1924; provided, that the states of Illinois, Iowa and Minnesota
21 grant a like consent, and all rights respectively reserved by said states, in addition
22 to the reservation herein made, are hereby reserved to this state; and provided,
23 further, that any acquisition by the government of the United States of land, or of
24 land and water, shall first be approved by the governor, on the advice of the
25 department of ~~natural resources~~ fish, wildlife, parks, and forestry.

1 **SECTION 1bL.** 1.055 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 **1.055 (1)** Consent of this state is given to the acquisition by the United States
3 by purchase, gift, lease or condemnation, with adequate compensation therefor, of
4 such areas of land not exceeding 2,000,000 acres as the United States deems
5 necessary for the establishment of national forests in the state, in accordance with
6 the act of congress approved June 7, 1924, and the board of commissioners of public
7 lands are authorized to sell and convey for a fair consideration to the United States
8 any state lands included within such areas; provided, that this state shall retain
9 concurrent jurisdiction with the United States in and over such areas so far that civil
10 process, in all cases, and such criminal process as may issue under the authority of
11 this state against any persons charged with the commission of any crime within or
12 without said areas, may be executed thereon in like manner as if this consent had
13 not been given. Provided, further, that the boundaries of any areas so selected shall
14 be first approved by the governor, the board of commissioners of public lands, the
15 department of ~~natural resources~~ fish, wildlife, parks, and forestry, and the county
16 board of each county in which any such area is located.

17 **SECTION 1bn.** 1.056 of the statutes is amended to read:

18 **1.056 State conservation areas.** Consent of this state is given to the United
19 States to acquire by purchase, gift, lease or condemnation, with adequate
20 compensation therefor, areas of land and water within boundaries approved by the
21 governor and the county board of the county in which the land is located, for the
22 establishment of state forests, state parks or other state conservation areas to be
23 administered by the state under long-term leases, treaties or cooperative
24 agreements, which the department of ~~natural resources~~ fish, wildlife, parks, and

1 forestry is hereby authorized to enter into on behalf of the state with the federal
2 government.”.

13 another statute fulfills this section. If no public hearing is otherwise required, the
14 responsible agency shall hold the hearing in the area affected. Notice of the hearing
15 shall be given by publishing a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, at least 15 days prior to
16 the hearing in a newspaper covering the affected area. If the proposal has statewide
17 significance, notice shall be published in the official state newspaper;”.

11 forestry.

14 The department of fish, wildlife, parks, and forestry may submit to the department
15 of environmental management written comments on legislation specified under sub.
16 (2) within 10 days after the legislation is introduced or offered.”.
