HIGHER EDUCATION

Current law prohibits the LW board of regents (board) from increasing resident, undergraduate tuition beyond an amount that is sufficient to fund certain costs, such as compensation and fringe benefits for UW employees and the costs of nontraditional courses, but permits the board to spend up to the entire amount of tuition received. Beginning in the 2002–03 academic year, this bill eliminates the restrictions on increasing resident undergraduate tuition.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.27 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
